



1. Diary 1889: Ames Rogers was an agricultural worker or a farmer. This is his diary for 1889. It records weather details, daily activities and tasks. If you choose this diary, you would need to write about Ames Rogers and research the life of farmers Ames Rogers' part of the USA. This diary would probably connect quite well with the life of Hubert Berry, a working class Englishman in the small Buckinghamshire village of Flackwell Heath, which is *The Diary of Another Nobody*, (Week 12).
